

WETLANDS PERMISSION FORM

As part of our Outdoor Education and Environmental Education curricula, our class will visit the Snoqualmie Wetlands Interpretive Trail on one or more occasions during this school year. The trail is located adjacent to Snoqualmie Elementary School, on school district property, and has been developed in conjunction with the educational goals of the Snoqualmie Valley School District.

It is necessary to have parental/guardian permission for students to visit the trail during the school year. By signing this form the parent/guardian acknowledges that these visits are voluntary, and that there are certain risks associated with visits to nature study sites, including but not limited to falls, insect bites and stings, allergic reactions, and scratches, stings or cut from plants. By signing this form, the parent/guardian agrees to hold harmless the Snoqualmie Valley School District from any and all claims arising from these voluntary field trips.

It is understood that precautionary care will be taken by school staff, including adequate supervision, and the presence of first aid supplies. All students will be within eyesight of an adult at all times during these excursions.

These field trips are under the authority of the Snoqualmie Valley School District #410. Any comments or questions regarding field trips should be addressed to school officials.
